~~In addition, following discussions with the administration, the board has created two additional opportunities to communicate with students, families, and the broader Hermiston stakeholders, as well as educational information from stakeholders about the various district programs.~~

~~As an agricultural community, Hermiston has many parents who work in the fields for long hours during the summer months. To assist with this, the district offers a summer school program at the elementary level, HSD offers summer camp opportunities to support~~

~~the district partners with the city's Parks and Recreation Department to offer swim lessons and other sports camps. Through partnership with "Gymnastics," HSD offers childcare until 6:30 p.m. to accommodate parents who work longer hours during the summer months. Similarly, the district partners with Umatilla-Morrow County Head Start to offer a "Little Pups" pre-school program to provide preschool to children whose~~

Perhaps most importantly, Hermiston School District emphasizes the student as the cornerstone to the success of all earners. These programs reinforce student opportunities to learn and succeed, including a "Think Big" grant partnership with Amazon related to STEAM education. High school students are offered a robust selection of postsecondary pathways through dual enrollment opportunities, apprenticeship programs, and internships. The district is also in the process of developing a co-op apprenticeship program in collaboration with the Operating Engineers Local 701 to provide an additional pathway for students.

Finally, the school district is committed to aligning its services with local governmental and resource agencies. It offers extensive parent seminars, family mental health nights, and a mobile food distribution van. Additionally, HSD has a dedicated Wellness Clinic at Hermiston High School to provide non-emergency care for individuals with medical conditions. It also partners with the Umatilla County Health Department to provide both vaccinations and immunization clinics for students and staff. Four full-time counselors work at the school to provide individualized support to students' needs beyond their academic achievement. Other community partners include Community Counseling Solutions during the school day.
